


## Seeing your grades

How are you doing so far? It's good to check the website to make sure that what we have is what we are supposed to have. So go back to the course home page, and look in the left column. In the "Navigation" block, there is a link with a link to "Grades." (You may need to scroll down to see it). (In some cases, material that is normally in the left column will have been moved to tabs in the left margin – note the icons in the upper right corner of each block – but the default is for it to be displayed in the left column.)

Every course will have a different grade structure. This one is organized into categories: forums, quizzes, and papers. You can see the overall score on each assignment, a percentage score, and the way it totals when weighted according to the importance of the categories. If the instructor has typed comments into the website, you can also see those. You can also see where scores are missing – that might be something to ask about.
